He is the founding and chief editor of an academic journal, *Global Networks: A Journal of Transnational Affairs* (Wiley-Blackwell).

Noel Castree is Professor of Human Geography at Manchester University and has a wide range of expertise in the subject. He has authored and edited several books, including *Nature* (2005, Routledge), *Remaking Reality* (with Bruce Braun, 1998, Routledge), and *David Harvey: A Critical Reader* (with Derek Gregory, 2008). He is also a senior editor of the recent *International Encyclopedia of Human Geography* (2009, Elsevier) and a contributor to the *Encyclopedia of Human Geography* and the forthcoming *International Encyclopedia of Geography* (2014, Wiley-Blackwell).

Rob Kitchin is a Professor of Human Geography and Director of the National Institute for Regional and Spatial Analysis (NIRSA) at the National University of Ireland, Maynooth.
