

The third part explains what can be learnt from Australian child welfare history to improve our current understanding of the relation between the state, family life and childhood. The book may be of value to students of sociology, social history, education, criminology and the human services, as well as practitioners interested in relating social theory to practical concerns such as child abuse and neglect, juvenile delinquency and family breakdown.
