Maintaining that understanding TV is a matter of understanding "its key shows," Stark understands 60 of them. For example, *America's Funniest Home Videos*, he opines, is "the most democratic show on television-a populist rebellion packaged as programming" because it makes "the audience at home the stars" while "giving the studio audience the power to decide the best video of the show"; furthermore, it was most popular when the Berlin Wall was torn down *and* when a "virtually unprecedented number of voters" went for H. Ross Perot! Coincidence or sign o' the times? Analyzing the implications of stuff like *Howdy Doody* and *The Beverly Hillbillies* is always fun, and Stark does it deftly and impudently. Oh, his take on how Milton Berle clips fail to amuse today, though making some good, mildly cruel points, can recall the sage who loved Abbott and Costello but felt the Three Stooges were undignified. Yet his effort is always great browsing, even (especially?) when he shows his radical stripes--he disses Ed Murrow! *Mike Tribby*
